Historical background

First introduced in 1957, the FC series truck featured a cab-over-engine configuration that allowed greater rear cargo space while maintaining a short wheelbase. This cab-over-engine (COE) set up could be seen on heavy-duty trucks of the time, but it was unique to have this on a light duty truck. Based on the CJ-5 platform, the FC-150 offered what was called the "Safety View" cab which featured an extraordinary amount of glass. The windshield alone had almost 1,200 square inches of surface area. Access to the engine was through a removable cover in the interior. The FC was available from 1957 through 1965.
